IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Philip Drive Neighborhood Residents:

Beginning Thursday, April 24, 2008, weather permitting, Vangelis Construction, the Township's Contractor, will begin preliminary work consisting of road repairs and milling of the existing pavement for the entire length of Philip Drive. The work is planned to begin at 7:00 AM and is anticipated to be completed in two days, weather permitting.

Residents are asked to remove vehicles from their driveways on Wednesday night or early Thursday morning, prior to the start of work. Please note that the concrete work will be continuing on Philip Drive. Residents will be allowed to park on Hemlock Circle (only in the areas where the new asphalt base has been installed), Riverside Drive, or Prospect Avenue. Residents will have access to their driveways at the end of each day. In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following day.

Work hours will be between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Provisions will be made for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
