

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWNSHIP  
OF PRINCETON CONCERNING THE  
SPEED LIMIT ON SYCAMORE ROAD  
AND AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW  
JERSEY, 1968".

WHEREAS, the speed limit for Sycamore Road between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West is mistakenly established as thirty-five (35) miles per hour in Section 11-2(a) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968"; and

WHEREAS, the Princeton Township Police Department Traffic Safety Bureau has conducted a speed survey and confirmed that the appropriate speed limit for Sycamore Road between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West as set forth in Section 11-2(t) of said Code is thirty (30) miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes, therefore, to clarify the speed limit of Sycamore Road between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West as thirty (30) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of the Princeton as follows:

1. Sec. 11.2(a) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes a thirty-five (35) mile per hour speed limit for various streets or parts of streets within the Township of Princeton is amended by deleting therefrom the following designated Road:  
  
SYCAMORE ROAD, both direction between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West.
2. The Princeton Township Committee hereby reaffirms that the speed limit for Sycamore Road, both directions, between Harrison Street and

Riverside Drive West as set forth in Section 11-2(1) of said Code shall be and remain thirty (30) miles per hour.

3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above-referenced thirty (30) mile per hour speed limit as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.
