

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING
STOPPING OR STANDING VEHICLES
ON STREETS OR PARTS OF STREETS
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON AND AMENDING THE
"CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:


1. Section 11-23.1 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which prohibits a person from stopping or standing a vehicle at any time upon certain streets with the Township of Princeton is amended by adding thereto in alphabetical order the following designations:

Guyot Avenue. North side, from Moore Street to Ewing Street.

Herrontown Road. South side, from Route 206 (State Road) to Mt.
Lucas Road.

2. Section 11-8.1 of said Code is hereby repealed.
3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above-designated no stopping or standing regulations as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Princeton Township Committee held on April 6, 2009 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street, on April 20, 2009 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
