Vital information may need to be distributed to residents and businesses in a rapid fashion.

Telephone Notification

Princeton Township has acquired the services of **Rapid Notify**. **Rapid Notify** has a computerized telephone system that can target a general township wide area or a very specific area and send messages to over 13,000 phones per hour. If there is an emergency that may be a risk to Princeton Township, the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) will activate the system.

This form is intended for all new homes and businesses owners, renters or tenants. Please complete this form and re-direct it to the Office of Emergency Management AS SOON AS POSSIBLE Your physical address and telephone numbers will be incorporated into the Emergency Telephone database.
