**PSE&G ELECTRIC FACILITY CONSTRUCTION IN**  
**PRINCETON AND MONTGOMERY TOWNSHIPS**

**(December 1, 2011 – Newark, NJ)** Public Service Electric & Gas (PSE&G) Co., New Jersey's largest utility, is performing overhead electric construction work along Cherry Valley Rd. from Rt. 206 and Cherry Hill Rd. This work will allow PSE&G to continue to ensure safe, reliable electric service for area residents and business owners.

The project's construction activities will occur between January 2 and March 31, 2012. The work is being done in the public road rights-of-way. Work will occur in two areas as noted:

- Area #1 – Cherry Hill Road between Crestview Drive and Cherry Valley Road
- Area #2 – Cherry Valley Road between Cherry Hill Road and George Drive

To expedite this work and avoid creating delays during commuting hours, PSE&G has scheduled work hours from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday to Friday. It should be noted that the construction dates and scheduled work hours identified are tentative and subject to variations due to the construction process and/or inclement weather.

No major road closings are expected. However lane closures and/or detours will be necessary during construction, so motorists may want to travel an alternate route until the work is completed. Local police will be on site at all times to oversee new traffic patterns. Interruptions will be kept to a minimum.

For everyone's safety, PSE&G crews use work area protection including local police department traffic management assistance, traffic cones, barriers, utility work signage, and flaggers, providing measures for a safe project completion. The utility reminds motorists to slow down and be alert when driving past a PSE&G jobsite.
