

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
THE VACATION OF A STORM
DRAIN AND SANITARY SEWER
EASEMENT ON A PORTION OF
BLOCK 5706, LOT 5, PRINCETON
TOWNSHIP TAX MAP BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of the Princeton as follows:

1. Pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq.*, it has been determined that the Township of Princeton no longer needs the following storm drain and sanitary sewer easement on a portion Block 5706, Lot 5 and wishes to vacate same:

"Said tract is subject to a fifteen (15) feet wide right-of-way for a storm drain and sanitary sewer, adjoining the east line of the above premises. Said right-of-way extending from the north line of Overbrook Drive Northerly about one hundred and ninety-five (195) feet to the northerly side of the brook crossing said premises, as shown on the aforesaid map."


2. The existing fifteen (15) foot wide easement on the easement on the westerly side of said property shall be revised to read as follows:

"Excepting and reserving from said tract a fifteen (15) foot wide

right of way for the purpose of installing, using and maintaining therein a storm drain and sanitary sewer, the center line of said of way being twelve and one-half (12 1/2) feet easterly from and parallel to the westerly line of said tract and extending from Overbrook Drive northerly approximately two hundred (200) feet to the brook crossing the premises, the said right of way extending seven and one-half (7 1/2) feet on either side of the aforesaid center line."

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Princeton Township Committee held on January 28, 2008 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street, on February 11, 2008 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
