

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING
MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS ON WITHERSPOON
STREET AND MOUNT LUCAS ROAD
AND AMENDING THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1968**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of the
Princeton as follows:

1. Sec. 11.2(e) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes a twenty-five (25) mile per hour speed limit on various streets within the Township is amended by deleting therein the following reference:

[WITHERSPOON STREET, in the
Community Park School Zone during
recess or while children are going to or
leaving school, during opening or
closing hours.]

2. Sec. 11-2(f) which establishes 30 mile per hour speed limits on various streets or roads in the Township is amended by deleting therefrom the following references:

[MOUNT LUCAS ROAD, both
directions, between Valley Road and
Ewing Street.]

[WITHERSPOON STREET, both
directions, from the Princeton Borough
line to Mount Lucas Road, except as

otherwise provided with respect to the
Community Park School Zone.]

3. Sec. 11-2(f) which establishes 30 mile per hour speed limits on various streets and roads is amended by adding thereto the following new designation for Mount Lucas Road and shall read as follows:

MOUNT LUCAS ROAD, both directions
between Cherry Hill Road and Ewing
Street.

4. Sec. 11-2(e) which establishes twenty-five mile per hour speed limits on various streets and roads within the Township is amended by adding thereto in alphabetical order the following new designation:

MOUNT LUCAS ROAD, both direction
between Cherry Hill Road and Valley
Road.

5. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

Additions in text are indicated by underlining, deletions by {brackets}, except that underlined catchwords are not necessarily additions.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Princeton Township Committee held on April 23, 2007 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street, on May 21, 2007 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
