

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING
APPLICATION FEES AND ESCROW
DEPOSITS FOR HISTORIC
PRESERVATION PLAN APPROVAL AND
AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY 1968"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. *Section 10B-36(a) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes application fees and escrow account deposit requirements for land development applications is amended as it pertains to Historic Preservation plan applications and shall read as follows:*

<i>Preservation Plan Additions in text are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions by [brackets], except that underlined catchwords are not necessarily additions.</i>	<u>\$ 50.00</u>	<i>No escrow for plans approved pursuant to Section 10B-41.2(b); <u>\$150.00 for all others.</u></i>
