## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Dear Overbrook Drive and Abernathy Drive Neighborhood Residents:

Beginning Tuesday July 17, 2007, weather permitting, Vangelis Construction Company, the Township's Contractor, will be installing additional base course of pavement on Overbrook Drive starting at Broadripple Drive and working toward Snowden Lane. Once the Overbrook Drive base paving is completed, the contractor will then move (anticipated to occur in late morning) to Abernathy Drive and install the new base course of pavement along that street. The work is planned to begin at 6:00 AM and is planned to be completed in one day, weather permitting.

Residents are asked to remove vehicles from their driveways on Monday night, prior to the early start time scheduled for Tuesday. Residents will be allowed to park on Clover Lane, Magnolia Lane, Broadripple Drive or Shady Brook Lane. Vehicles should not be parked near the intersections with Overbrook Drive or Abernathy Drive in order to allow access for the paving equipment. Vehicles parking in the section of Clover Lane between Overbrook Drive and Abernathy Drive may enter/leave the neighborhood via Abernathy Drive in the morning and Overbrook Drive in the afternoon, after the paving on that street is completed. In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following day.

After the paving of the base course on the roadway is completed, you will be prohibited from using the road for a 1-hour period up until approximately 1 PM for Overbrook Drive and 6 PM for Abernathy Drive. This restriction will prevent permanent marring of the blacktop during its "curing period". Residents will then be allowed to return to their driveways once the road is opened.


Work hours will be between 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Provisions will be made for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.

You will be receiving further notice prior to the final paving of your roadways, which is scheduled to occur later in the week, weather permitting.
