

PRINCETON TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING
August 28, 2006

A meeting of Township Committee was held on this date at 1:00 p.m. in the clerk's conference room of the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street.

NOTICE OF MEETING

The Clerk read the following statement.

ROLL CALL

The Township Clerk then called the roll.

BID AWARD: Improvement of Overbrook Drive, Abernathy Drive and Clover Lane

Mr. Kiser said that bids were received for the above referenced project on August 21, 2006.

Included in the work is the installation of curbing per Township standards, storm drainage and sanitary sewer improvements, roadway reconstruction, repairs and resurfacing, installation of sidewalks along Overbrook Drive and top soiling and seeding along the roadways.

Two bids were received, one from Vangelis Construction, Edison, New Jersey and the second from Marvec Construction Corporation, Verona, New Jersey.

Mr. Kiser said that the low bid received from Vangelis Construction is competitive, coming in at 3.5% over the Engineering Department's prebid estimate.

Mrs. Bergman offered a motion to approve the resolution authorizing the bid award for the above referenced project to Vangelis Construction, Edison, New Jersey in the amount of \$1,587,237.75 as recommended by the Township Engineer.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Goerner and carried unanimously by those present.
